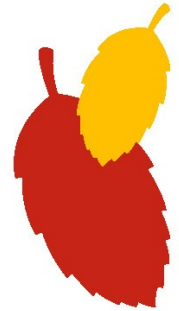
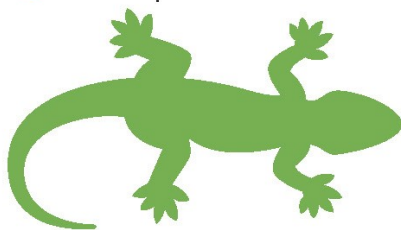


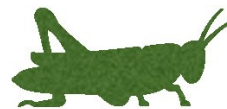
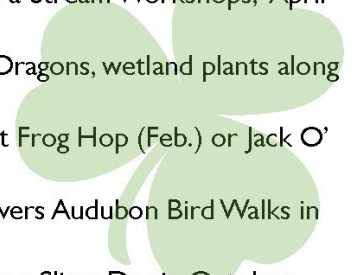


50 Ways to Celebrate!
